➤ Course Details

Name of the Course	:	Certificate Course in Communicative Arabic
Department	:	Department of Arabic, University of Kerala
Course Duration	:	6 Months (120 Hours)
Course Fee	:	INR 6000 (Rupees Six Thousand only)
Eligibility	:	Those who have successfully completed 10+2 OR equivalent
Class Timing	:	Evening / Weekend course

➤ Objectives

- To prepare students with no previous knowledge of Arabic to live and work in an Arabic - speaking environment.
- To make them capable to communicate effectively in Arabic in a wide range of situations, and to read and write Arabic with ease.
- To develop the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in a balanced way.

➤ Scheme of the Course

Certificate Course in Communicative Arabic is a six month Part time course with 120 teaching hours. The candidate will be declared eligible for receiving the Certificate in 'Communicative Arabic' on his completion of the course of studies prescribed, and passed the examination.

- A candidate is declared to have passed a subject, if he/she obtains not less than 35% of the marks prescribed for the subject.
- Successful candidates who obtain 80% and above marks will be placed in the first class with distinction.
- Successful candidates who obtain less than 80% and not less than 60% of marks will be placed in the first class.
- Successful candidates who obtain less than 60% and not less than 50% of marks will be placed in the second class.
- The other successful candidates obtaining less than 50% of marks will be placed in the third class.
