➤ Objectives

- To develop the skill of language acquisition through LSRW methods
- To create the situations of language learning through different approaches
- To prepare students to live and work in an Arabic-speaking environment

➤ Scheme of the Course

Diploma in Communicative Arabic is a six month Part time course with 120 teaching hours. The candidate will be declared eligible for receiving the Certificate in 'Diploma in Communicative Arabic' on his completion of the course of studies prescribed, and passed the examination.

- A candidate is declared to have passed a subject, if he/she obtains not less than 35% of the marks prescribed for the subject.
- Successful candidates who obtain 80% and above marks will be placed in the first class with distinction.
- Successful candidates who obtain less than 80% and not less than 60% of marks will be placed in the first class.
- Successful candidates who obtain less than 60% and not less than 50% of marks will be placed in the second class.
- The other successful candidates obtaining less than 50% of marks will be placed in the

third class.
